While the alcohol and salt method is highly effective for removing thick resin, it completely fails to address another highly common issue that plagues glass collectors: hard water stains. When we carelessly leave tap water sitting inside the base of our pipe for several days, the dissolved calcium and heavy minerals slowly adhere to the glass, leaving highly stubborn, cloudy white rings that make the piece look completely permanently dirty. Isopropyl alcohol cannot break

down these tough mineral deposits. To completely remove hard water stains, we must briefly soak the affected areas in pure, undiluted white vinegar for thirty to forty minutes. The natural acidity of the vinegar gently dissolves the tough calcium bonds without damaging the glass. After the vinegar soak, we must thoroughly rinse the entire piece multiple times with warm distilled water to completely remove the sharp vinegar smell and completely prevent any new mineral deposits from actively forming as the glass slowly air dries on the counter.
